Boxer (1998) is about open and closed spaces and what is in between. And like it's big brother the Low version also has hand-painted end faces forming a pattern of gray lines. With Boxer, Alexander van Straten was the first Dutch designer who published in trendsetting British Wallpaper magazine: "this work is architecturally impressive."
